

Ubrelvy[®] Financial Assistance Guide

A newer class of medications has been approved by the FDA for the acute treatment of migraine in adults. These drugs are referred to as calcitonin gene-related peptide (CGRP) receptor antagonists.

Ubrelvy is currently the only one of these oral medications on the market.

Ubrelvy may be covered by most insurers, but numerous patients still have out-of-pocket costs. If you are prescribed Ubrelvy, AbbVie is offering financial assistance programs to help cover the costs. Each program is different and various programs exist to support patients with private or public insurance, as well as the uninsured.

I Have Been Prescribed Ubrelvy. What Financial Assistance Programs Exist To Help Me?

I Have a Private/Commercial Insurance Plan

This category includes insurance plans provided through an employer, purchased with subsidy support from the Affordable Care Act (Obamacare) or purchased privately.

Highlights of U-Save Card

Depending on your insurance coverage of Ubrelvy, you can use the U-Save card and pay as little as \$10 for each monthly prescription – \$0 - for up to 13 prescription fills. Your out-of-pocket expense may vary – check with your pharmacist.

Steps To Get Your U-Save Card

STEP 1 - Your doctor writes you a prescription for Ubrelyv.

STEP 2 - Obtain a U-Save Card online at <https://ubrelvy.com/savings> or by texting UBRELVY to 48764

STEP 3 - Take your prescription (if your doctor did not call it in to your pharmacy) and Savings Card to your regular retail pharmacy to be filled. The Savings Card includes important information you need to provide the pharmacist to connect your prescription to the offered savings. If you have any trouble please call 1-844-UBRELVY (1-844-482-7358).

* To activate your Savings Card online visit <https://ubrelvy.com/savings>. Choose "Activate an Existing Card". You will then be prompted to complete the following steps:

- 1 Answer the Savings Card eligibility questions – please confirm that you are a resident of the US or Puerto Rico, NOT enrolled in a government-funded prescription program.
- 2 Provide your contact information, gender and date of birth.
- 3 Read and accept the terms and conditions for each disclosure.
- 4 You will receive an email with your U-Save card information. Be sure to save this and show it to your Pharmacist

You can also activate a card via SMS; simply text UBRELVY to 48764.

If You Need Prior Authorization



AbbVie will work behind the scenes to get your doctor to complete a prior authorization form and to get your insurance company to cover your Ubrelyv prescription. To be a proactive and engaged patient, you should contact your doctor's office to see if they have completed the Ubrelyv prior authorization form on your behalf and your insurance company to see if they will be covering your prescribed medicine. I Have Medicare, Medicaid or other Government Insurance Plan

The U-Save Card is not available to patients whose medical insurance is provided by state or federal programs, like Medicare and Medicaid.

The Federal Government does not allow people who are receiving insurance benefits through Medicare, Medicaid, etc. to use co-pay assistance, discount or savings cards offered by pharmaceutical companies. The intent is to steer patients to lower-cost generic drugs and not to support higher-cost brand-name drugs.

I Am Uninsured

The U-Save Card is not available to patients who are uninsured or underinsured.

You may be eligible to receive Ubrelvy at no cost from the AbbVie Patient Assistance Program if you meet the requirements. Download and complete an application at abbvie.com/patients/patient-assistance/program-qualification/ubrelvy-tablets-program-selection.html

Dosing & Administration for Migraine	50 mg or 100 mg taken orally – if needed a second dose may be administered at least 2 hours after the initial dose. (maximum dose in a 24-hour period is 200 mg). Your doctor can help determine which dose is right for you.
Indication	Acute treatment of migraine attacks with or without aura in adults living with migraine disease.
